

Adkins-Ford Scholarship Fund 2024 Application Package

SCPCA sets a high priority on educating future generations. Through the Adkins-Ford and Pat Zungoli Award scholarship projects, SCPCA makes several grants each year to pest management professionals, thier children and grandchildren. Since the creation the scholarship projects, the SCPCA has contributed more than \$350,000 to promote further education of our members and their families. Submissions for the 2024 scholarship awards are due by June 30, 2024 and the winners will be announced by July 30, 2024.

Scholarships will be given to students whose parent or immediate family member is actively engaged in the South Carolina pest control industry. These funds can be used to further the recipient's education at the college of their choice. Review the following information carefully to determine qualifications; then complete the application on the next page.

To be eligible for the 2024 SCPCA Scholarship, please make sure you have completed the following application AND include all 5 items below:

- 1. Completed application.
- 2. Letter of recommendation from licensed SCPCA member, high school teacher or college professor. (PDF file preferred)
- 3. Copy of most recent school transcript. (PDF file preferred)
- 4. Letter of school acceptance if entering freshman or changing schools. (PDF file preferred)
- 5. Essay Topic (minimum 250 words) "What is the greatest challenge facing the pest control industry today and what can be done about it?" (PDF file preferred)

SAVE a copy of the fillable application package to your computer.

PROCEDURE

- Scholarships are funded from interest received from SCPCA scholarship fund, dollars raised at the SCPCA Pest Pro Summit's silent auction and from Verifiable Training testing.
- Amount of scholarship awarded will be determined by the funds available and the scholarship committee. All funds are paid to the scholarship winner in July.

All applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Parent or immediate family member must be from a SCPCA member company in good standing. Applicant must be a full time (12 hours or more per semester) student
